Instructions
for beginners



You will need:



Scissors



Pencil



Bunting Tape



Fabric



Needle &
Thread



Iron

Pattern side



Stitch



None pattern side

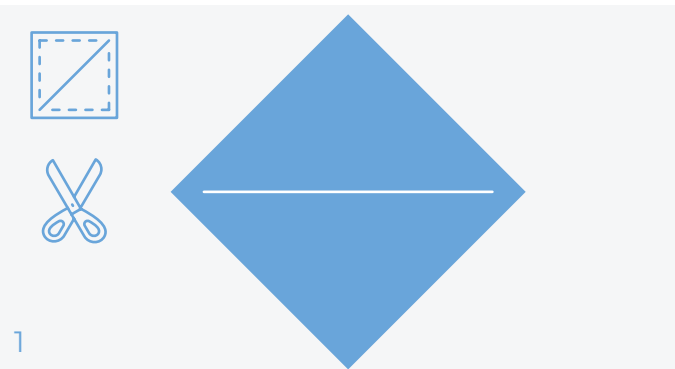

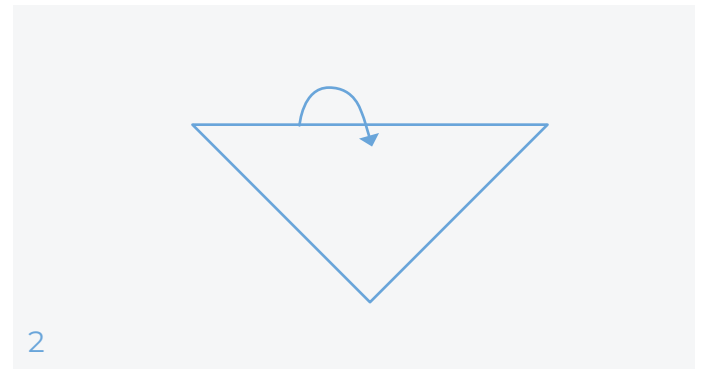
Top Tip

You could even do a variety of flag sizes for a unique piece!

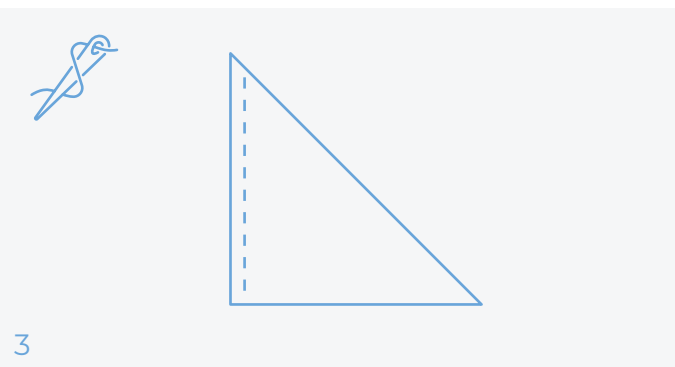
Instructions:



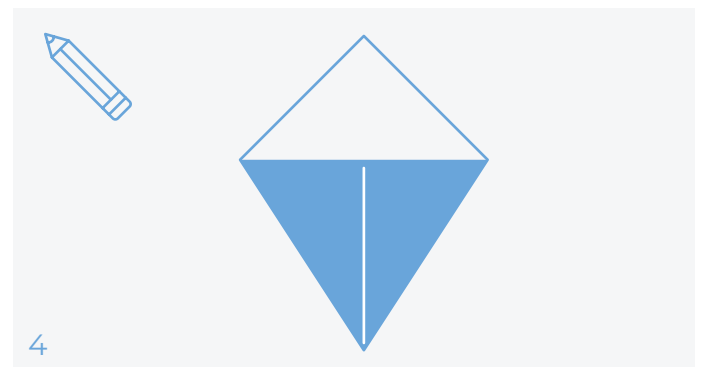
Select your fabric style. Cut your fabrics into equal squares (5in / 12cm minimum)



Take your square of fabric and fold it on the diagonal to make a triangle, ensuring that the print you want on show is on the inside.



Sew one of the open sides closed.



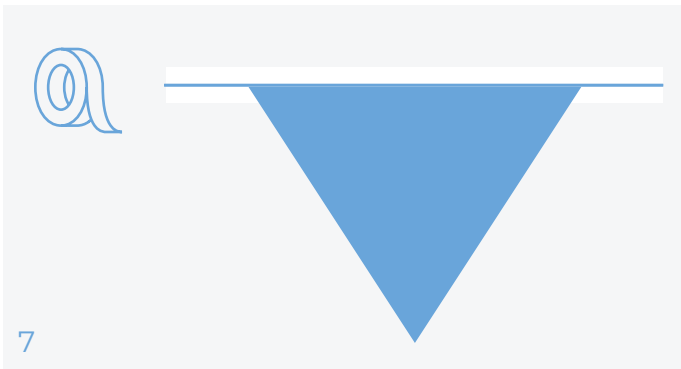
Turn your fabric inside out, and using something pointy such as scissors or a pencil, push the fabric to the end of the closing to make a long 'kite' shape. The seam should be running down the centre back.



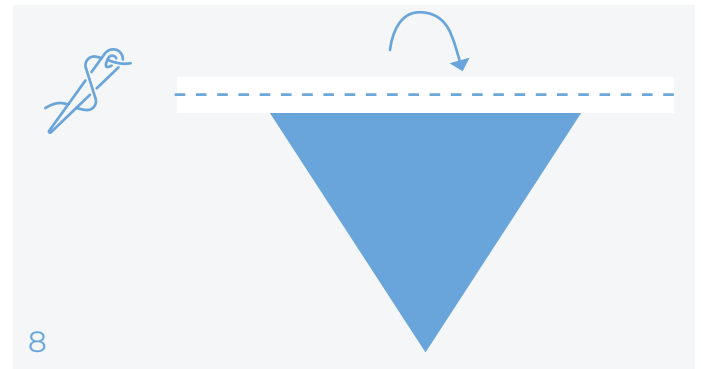
Fold the top of the fabric inwards to make your desired triangle bunting shape.



Press down all sides so that the bunting is flat.



Take your bunting tape or a long, thin piece of fabric to attach your bunting flags to.



Fold the tape or fabric over either side of the flag and sew each flag onto it. Repeat for each, flag, spacing them.

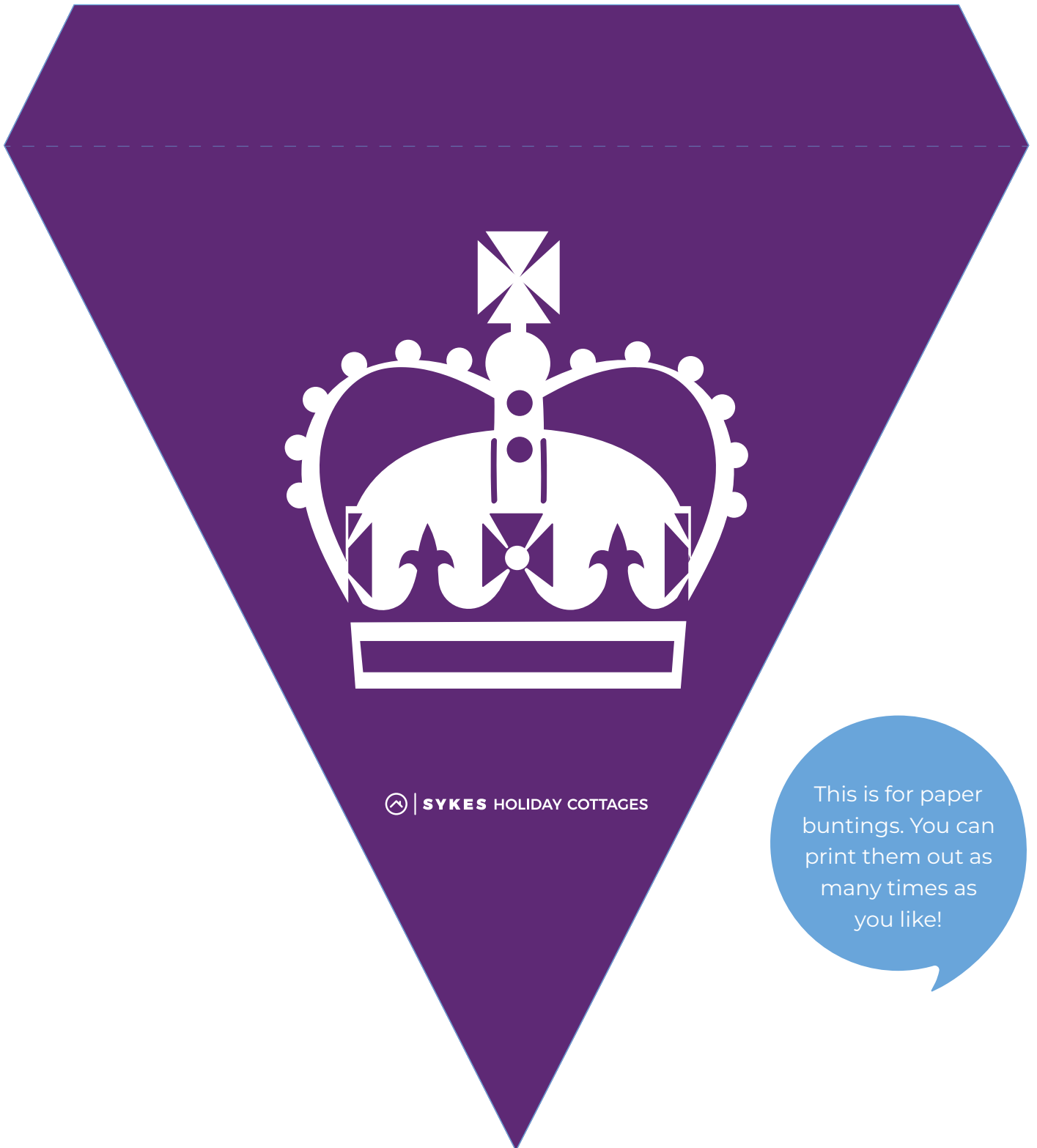
